Is it you?

In your role, you will provide analytical and research support to the COCERAL-EUROMALT-UNISTOCK team, with a particular focus on, but not limited to:

- food & feed safety, with a focus on emerging issues that have a direct and/or indirect impact on the latter;
- sustainable farming practices and trade;
- biotechnology,
- logistics.

You will be performing political, economic, social and technological monitoring in order to support the team's knowledge and understanding of emerging issues which will/might have an impact on COCERAL's members and their interests. Depending on arising needs, you will help updating relevant COCERAL-EUROMALT-UNISTOCK databases.

Specifically, tasks will be:

- monitoring relevant sources on agri raw materials, food, feed and environmental intelligence, including news trackers;
- maintenance of COCERAL-EUROMALT-UNISTOCK databases (on pesticides, contaminants, mycotoxins, GMOs...) on regulatory thresholds and limits;
- coverage of the European Parliament, Council and Commission work relevant to COCERAL, EUROMALT and UNISTOCK with the objective of reporting developments and anticipating relevant discussions;
- assisting in stakeholder engagement, outreach, and events, including participation in relevant stakeholder groups in Brussels;
- monitoring key food & feed safety notifications issued by the WTO (SPS) and non-EU countries' regulatory agencies that could have political and regulatory consequences on COCERAL-EUROMALT-UNISTOCK members;
- provide structured updates on the RASFF and TRACES and building relevant intelligence.

This list of tasks is not exhaustive and may further expand, depending on EU policy developments.



Qualifications and skills:

- you have a University Degree in one of the following fields: life sciences, including agricultural sciences; chemistry, microbiology, environmental sciences, or in another discipline that is relevant in the context of this vacancy;
- you have previous professional experience (1-3 years) in the field of food and agricultural policies at the EU level (an EU institution, European association, international organisation) dealing with EU Law;
- you are a self-starter, organised and accustomed to project management;
- you work well in a team;
- you have excellent communication and language skills - highly proficient in spoken and written English and fluent in at least one other official language of the EU, preferably French;
- you have an outstanding command of Microsoft Excel and IT tools relevant to database maintenance; you also have experience in processing, analysing and interpreting data.
